Do not drop off your child prior to class times and be prompt picking him/her up at the end of the programs. For your child's safety, please come into the program location to drop off and pick up your child.

Refund Policy

- Refunds are available for cancellations made at least one week (**5 business days**) prior to the program start date. **A \$5 cancellation fee will be deducted from the refund amount.**
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations made within 24 hours of the program start date or once the program has begun, unless the program is canceled by the Recreation Department.
- Refunds due to participant illness or injury will be considered with the submission of a doctor's note. A prorated refund may be issued, minus the cost of uniforms, supplies, and the \$5 cancellation fee.
- For facility rentals, such as the Charlie Maier Lodge, please refer to the rental agreement for specific cancellation and refund terms.
