Pre-registration is required for all programs unless otherwise noted!

If a program is cancelled due to low enrollment, all registered participants will be notified. We do not send activity reminders so plan accordingly.

Do not drop off your child prior to class times and be prompt picking him/her up at the end of the programs. For your child's safety, please come into the program location to drop off and pick up your child.

Refund Policy

Refunds will be given to anyone cancelling from an activity at least one week (5 business days) prior to the start of the program minus a 5% cancellation fee if a cash refund is requested. If an account credit is requested the cancellation fee is waived. There is no refund for any program once it has begun unless it is cancelled by the Recreation Department or in the event of participant illness or injury (documentation is required). Refund may be pro-rated minus the cost of uniforms and supplies.

Explore Archery Fundamentals

Expand upon skills learned in the Level 1 Program in this 5 week introductory program. Each week we will focus on topics ranging from Safety, Equipment, Form, Shot Execution, and Scoring. The Level 2 Program features new games and focuses on personal development of individual archers.

This course is taught by certified USA Archery Instructors.

You are not permitted to bring your own bow to this course.

Gymnastics Camp

Our weeklong gymnastics camp will return this Summer. Participants will learn to use various gymnastics equipment like the balance beam, parallel bars, uneven bars, and vault. Mats will be laid out for focus on floor routines and developing tumbling skills. There is no specific uniform requirement, however, participants are asked to wear comfortable clothing, pack socks, and to bring a water bottle.

To join the Preschool Program your child must be at least 3 years old, able to follow directions and be comfortable without parents being in the same room.

Intermediate gymnasts must be able to do cartwheels, backward rolls, and bridges on their own.

This program fills quickly so early registration is advised to guarantee your child's spot. If the program is full please sign up for the waitlist as spots may open after the first class.

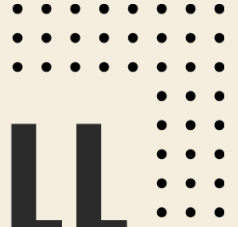
