6. If available and seats are full, check the box next to the names of any members you wish to waitlist.
7. Click Check Out to view the cart and items within it. Pay via the online check out system or stop in the office to make cash or check payments.

If a program is cancelled due to low enrollment, all registered participants will be notified. We do not send activity reminders so plan accordingly.

Do not drop off your child prior to class times and be prompt picking him/her up at the end of the programs. For your child's safety, please come into the program location to drop off and pick up your child.

## Refund Policy

Refunds will be given to anyone cancelling from an activity at least one week (5 business days) prior to the start of the program. There is no refund for any program once it has begun unless it is cancelled by the Recreation Department or in the event of participant illness or injury (documentation is required).
