Important Notices

Pre-registration is required for all programs unless otherwise noted!

Do not drop off your child prior to class times and be prompt picking him/her up at the end of the programs. For your child's safety, please come into the program location to drop off and pick up your child.

Refund Policy

- **Cancellations:** Must be made **5 business days** prior to the program start date to qualify for a refund.
- **Fees:** **\$10 cancellation fee will be deducted from the refund amount.**
- **No Refunds:** If canceled within 5 business days of the program start date or once the program has begun, unless the program is canceled by the Recreation Department.
- **Participant Illness or Injury:** Refunds considered with the submission of a doctor's note. A pro-rated refund may be issued, minus the cost of uniforms, supplies, and the \$10 cancellation fee.
- **Facility Rentals:** Please refer to the rental agreement for specific cancellation and refund terms.
- **All Refunds are subject to Town Board Approval.**

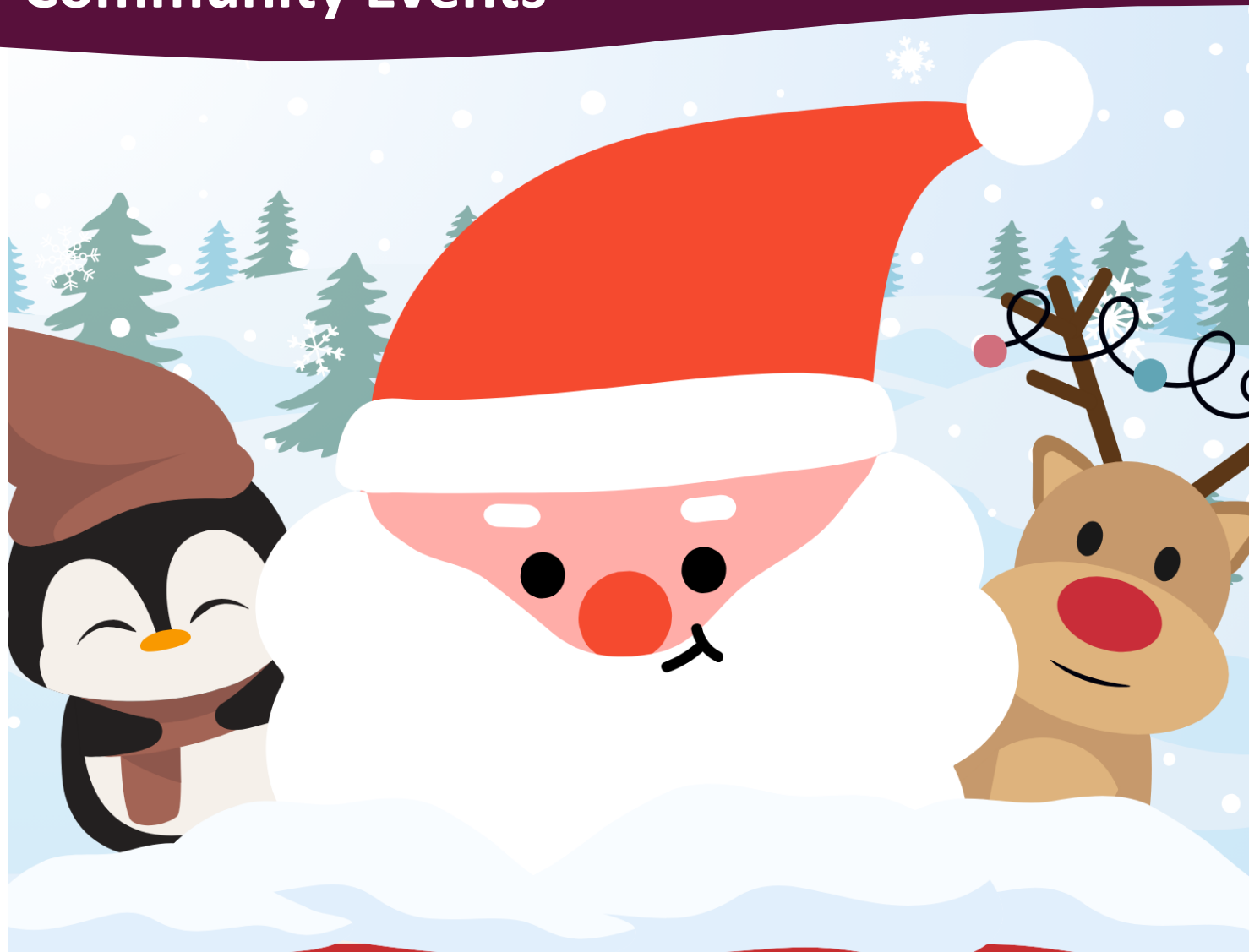

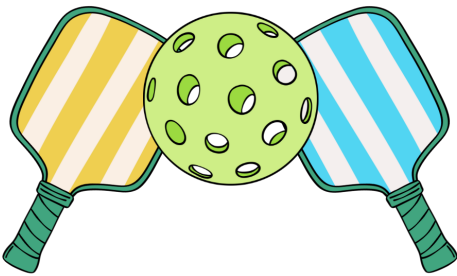
